



WEDDING DAY SHOT LIST

*This list contains a set of Targeted Images I will be collecting.

Reception/Ceremony site shots (This is before the Ceremony):

1. Multiple shots inside the Venue - The whole space
2. Close up shots of various decorative items (Centerpieces, Cake, Mr. and Mrs. Table, guest gallery, Wedding book, etc.)
3. Shot of Plate Setting
4. Shots of Ceremony location
5. Close up of Vegetation in and around the venue

Pre- Getting ready shots:

1. Rings on wedding Invites, Shoes, etc.
2. All Bouquets lined up together.
3. Bride's Hair being done
4. Makeup being done on Bride and Bridesmaids (Lipstick in mirror)
5. Bride looking at Dress
6. Mom Zipping up the dress
7. Putting on Bride's Shoes
8. Putting on Ear Rings
9. Bride looking at her reflection
10. Mom Looking at bride in Mirror
11. Mom and Me - Smiling at each other
12. Bridesmaids looking at bride
13. Bride and the Groom's Mother Dressed up (Mother in-Law and Me shot)
14. Bride and Bride's Father First reaction
15. Bride and Grandparents (Individually and/or all together)
16. Flower Girl with Basket
17. Ring Bearer
18. Flower Girl and Ring Bearer
19. Bride with Flower Girl and Ring Bearer
20. Bride outside with Bouquet (Solo with Scenery)
 - a. Front and Back shots of Bride's outfit
21. Close up of Bride holding Bouquet
 - a. Can also include shot of Hand with the Ring
22. Bride and Bridesmaids in a line covering their faces with and without their Bouquets

First Look (Please tell me beforehand if this is something you plan on doing):

1. Frontal Shot of Groom (Blurred)
2. Bride appears, Groom blurred then Bride Blurred (2 shots)
3. Groom Turns around, Seeing bride for the first time
4. Closeup of both faces looking at each other
5. Head-head, Nose-nose touching (Romantic)
6. Kissing
7. Bride Holding Suspenders/Lapels in hands, bringing groom close

Ceremony:

1. Pastor Standing under Archway
2. Each of the Bridesmaids and Groomsmen walking the aisle
3. Groom and Groom's Mom Walking the aisle
4. Groom standing, awaiting bride
5. Several Shots of Flower Girl
6. Several Shots of Ring Bearer
7. Bride and Bride's Father walking the Aisle
8. Back shots (Bride and Groom facing the Pastor)
9. Side shots (Bride Side, Groom Side)
 - a. Shots of both including bridesmaids and groomsmen
10. Close up shot of Bride and Groom's arms linked together (Possibly before walking down the aisle together)
11. Holding hands under Arch
12. Shot of the Pastor Speaking to Bride and Groom (If there is anything planned here, please let me know)
13. Shots of the Reading of Vows
14. "You may kiss the Bride" (PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE let me know if there will be a dip)
15. Bride and Groom Walking Aisle together

Cocktail Hour (*This is where we will get the Formal images done, please do not socialize with guests until the reception*):

[There will be 3 photo variations for most of the following:]

1. The Whole Wedding Party together (Bridesmaids, Bride, Groom, Groomsmen)
 - a. With Fun and Silly shots
2. Shots of ONLY the Bride with Wedding Party
 - a. Bride with Bridesmaids individually
 - b. Fun and Silly shots for each

3. Shots of ONLY the Groom with Wedding Party
 - a. Groom with Groomsmen individually
 - b. Fun and Silly shots for each
4. B&G with Flower Girl and Ring Bearer
5. B&G with Parents, then including Grandparents
6. B&G with Siblings
7. [Optional] B&G with extended Family, then their families

Dismiss Everyone to Reception except Bride and Groom

8. A Series of Husband and Wife Shots (Generally close-up portraits)
 - a. Groom Gently Hugging from behind
 - b. Bride Leaning into Groom's chest, showcasing ring.
 - c. Close up of the Hands with Rings (His over Hers)
 - d. Bride showing off shoes to the groom
 - e. Groom looking at the Camera embracing the Bride, Bride looking wistfully away into the future
 - f. B&G together, looking away
 - g. B&G playfully/lightly dancing
 - h. B&G Kissing under the veil

Reception:

1. Each of the Bridesmaids and Groomsmen as they walk into Reception Area
2. Many Shots of the B&G walking into the Reception Area
3. Many Shots of B&G first Dance
4. Many Shots of Bride and Groom dancing with their parents (Father and Mother, respectively)
5. B&G at Sweetheart table
6. Cake Cutting
 - a. Giving each other the first bite of cake
7. Bouquet Toss
8. Garter Toss
9. Many Shots of Guests dancing throughout the night
 - a. Focused on B&G when able
10. Candid shots of guests having fun
